Black Creek Golf Course was established in 1981 and has matured quite well over the years. It is a 9 hole semi-private course playing at 1897 yards. This course is well maintained and has a challenging design. The Black Creek runs through the course and comes into play on three holes. They also have a restaurant, driving range, putting green and welcome tournaments.

Widder Station Golf , Grill & Tap House

In 1859, the Grand Trunk Railway built its track just north of the Town of Widder, (originally known as Pinehill). The Railway line linked Toronto to Chicago. Nelson Southworth, an early settler, laid out a townsite on his lands near the new railway line and donated property for the railway station.

The names Widder and Widder Station have long disappeared from the area's current geography but, we feel that history should play a part in our golf course and development. Craft Beer Tap House, Tournaments and Event Facility rounds out the offerings here at Widder Station.
